








Second only to agriculture, the manufacturing and construction sector is the largest employer and contributor to economic activity in India...

The rest relates to industrial activities, residential and commercial development etc.





In 2012, India had an estimated housing shortage of 18.8 million urban and rural dwellings...




Present levels of urban infrastructure are inadequate to meet the demands of the existing urban population.



There is need for re-generation of urban areas in existing cities and the creation of new, inclusive smart cities to meet the demands of increasing population and migration from rural to urban areas.




The Government of India is in the process of launching a new urban development mission that will help develop 500 cities, including those with a population of more than 100,000 people
